



How much does it cost?

\$325 before April 15th - o r - \$350 after April 15th
Please note that no one will be denied participation because of an inability to pay.

How can I register?

1. The only way to register for camp is online. You can go to the website (www.camprock.me) and click on the Camp ROCK logo and you be directed to the main page with a link to the registration forms.

2. A \$100.00 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of registration. Make checks out to "Camp ROCK" and **send checks to:**

3. The remaining balance of \$225 and camp forms are due no later than April 15, 2020. After April 15th, your remaining balance is \$250

4. Failure to pay by the required dates will result in the loss of your spot at camp, unless other arrangements have been made in advance.

5. Due to the limited number of camper spots available, registration will be on a first-come, first-serve basis. Be sure to sign up early because the camp fills fast!
